


Welcome to Week 7

This week, your child will be practicing using the words "in" and "out" when locating an item. If your child is working on verbally speaking or signing, they will be practicing putting an object "in" and "out". If your child uses an AAC device, they will touch the "in" and "out" button to locate an object.

The concept of the week is comparing <u>"fast"</u> vs. <u>"slow".</u> The letter of the week is "E"

Ideas for home practice:

- Go to a local farm and point out different farm animals (ex: "cow", "horse" "sheep") or watch Old McDonald and point out farm animals.
- Walk around the room with your child at a fast and slow pace.
- Practice putting toys "in" and "out" of a container or box.
- Watch "The Letter E Song" on ABCmouse.com. Pause the video and point out various pictures that start with "E".
